An evaluation of member activity will determine the extent to which the membership is working toward this objective. Members who take advantage of the network by consistently acquiring information and failing to communicate their own research or critique of understanding will be dropped on the premise of unwillingness to interact. The primary objectives of the network are to learn, understand and develop ideas for mutual benefit.

BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP

The *ESJ* network administrators will connect researchers doing similar work. Researchers possessing different talents and means can then work together to further their investigations. This will be a difficult and scattered task and it will take an enormous effort by all involved to make the administrative function work for everyone.

- As individuals and groups of researchers provide results, we will be able to document and catalog the research, and provide critiques by sending the results to networkers who have volunteered their time and expertise to review the work.
- The network members can receive informal reports providing accounts of the various investigations underway. This working interaction will allow the network members to keep up with what is going on, and possibly provide insight into their own work.
- Certain researchers may need additional contacts, such as a mathematician or a model builder. The network can provide the names of members who are willing to offer assistance in these areas.
- When papers or reports are written, the network can provide a secure and permanent location to file and record the work.
- Members will have access to their files and reports and to those of others which have not had any restrictions imposed.
- Through the *Electric Spacecraft Journal*, members have the means to publish their findings and have their work recognized by readers around the world.
